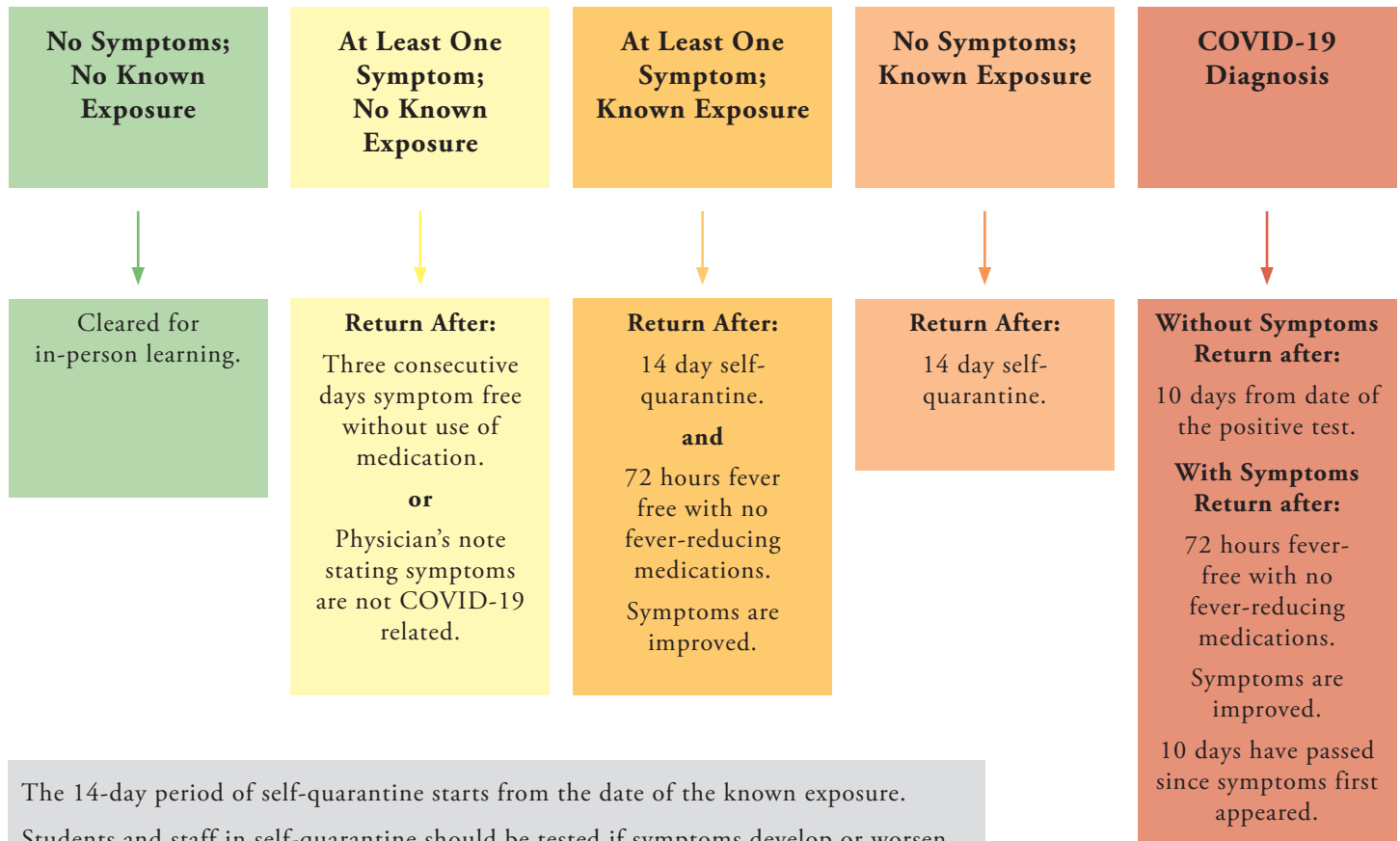


COVID-19 RETURN TO SCHOOL SCREENING CHART

Anyone (student or staff) who is showing signs or symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (as defined by the current CDC recommendations), or who has had a known exposure to someone with COVID-19, is asked to stay home and not return to school until meeting the following conditions for return.

COVID-19 Screening When can my child come to school?



The 14-day period of self-quarantine starts from the date of the known exposure. Students and staff in self-quarantine should be tested if symptoms develop or worsen. Positive test results should be reported to the school.

- COVID-19 Symptoms** *(May appear 2-14 days after exposure)*
- Fever or Chills
 - Muscle Aches
 - Nausea / Vomiting
 - Cough
 - Headache
 - Diarrhea
 - Shortness of Breath
 - New Loss of Taste / Smell
 - Congestion / Runny Nose
 - Fatigue
 - Sore Throat

COVID-19 Exposure
Close contact with a COVID-19 positive individual that is less than six feet **and** no face coverings were used for longer than **15 minutes**.
